Thank you so much for your prayers and encouragement for the Mongol Kids' Home.

The prayer we offered to God in January 2018 to "start up before the next winter" has been answered by God! In March, we began planning the project in collaboration with Ulaanbaatar's "The Glory of the Lord Community Church", and on September 9, opened the 1st home with six manhole children (whose parents are also manhole children).

There are 3 full time and 3 part time Mongolian staff, and volunteers on a 24-hour shift from Monday to Friday. As for the weekly routine, if the children have a family, they go home to their family that live in the manhole during the weekend and return to the group home Sunday night. At first it was difficult for them to live in a group home, but we began receiving pictures of kids eating warm meals with their own cups and plates, wearing freshly washed clothes, and getting along well. I noticed more smiles on the children's faces lately. It is the fruit of the Mongolian staff's hard work and your prayers. The building was very old and at one time the wall that encased the stove (Mongolian style stove that heats the walls) broke down, but the staff & Boldo fixed it together, and they even renovated the rooms.

Boldo celebrated his 4th year as a Christian. His small tire repair shop in a cargo container was named the "Immanuel Repair Shop," and there I found his bible, covered in grease. I can tell his faith is steadily growing. It is still a challenge for Dasha and his wife to come to church since they are not believers yet. When he does come, he studies the alphabet. Please pray for Dasha and his family's salvation as well!

The "Dream Together 1000" campaign, started to bring 1000 people together to support in prayer, exceeded 930 people the 1st week of December. Thanks to the help of Ambassador Aoyagi, we may meet our goal of 1000 prayer warriors by the end of the year! After this, we plan to go to the next challenge, "Dream Together 2000" as the goal for the 2nd year. We would appreciate if you can continue to pray for this.
